A Book Reading and discussion:

Are you looking to book a meaningful Author Visit for your school? Or you are looking for a fun time with some learning thrown in?

Do you have an environmental unit of enquiry and wish to engage the children with stories that make an impact while learning?

The Green Dragon stories cover these main topics:

- Plastic Pollution in the Ocean
- Litter in Nature
- Feeding Wild Animals
- The Introduction of Non-Native Species and the impact on the environment.



Suzanne will read the requested story to your students , followed by an age appropriate Q&A session on how we can make changes to help our planet.

Engaging the children with warm, loving characters that are affected by human habits, the children take away a message of 'every little helps' and how to take action.

Visit duration: 30-60 minutes, age dependent.

Suzanne's story of how she embarked on her journey of writing stories for children is inspiring. Suzanne has held many workshops based on the topic 'Taking Action' and what that entails to make a difference when one feels passionately about a situation.

Originally from the UK, Suzanne has lived abroad most of her adult life. She moved to Hong Kong in 2015 with her husband, son and four-legged hiking companion!

Suzanne is a true nature enthusiast and environmental guardian. She is also a keen hiker and animal lover.

Compelled to write 'The Green Dragon' while working in a volunteer organization she founded back in 2017 (Green Dragons HK). Suzanne realised that educating youngsters was key very early into her journey,

Green Dragons HK, was formed after a series of devastating typhoons revealed the extent of plastic pollution in the ocean. Suzanne, a keen dragon boater herself, turned to the dragon boat community to take action. The aim of the organization is to encourage dragon boat teams to commit to plastic free paddling and to encourage dragon boat festival organisers to reduce single use plastic at race events.

The Green Dragon stories

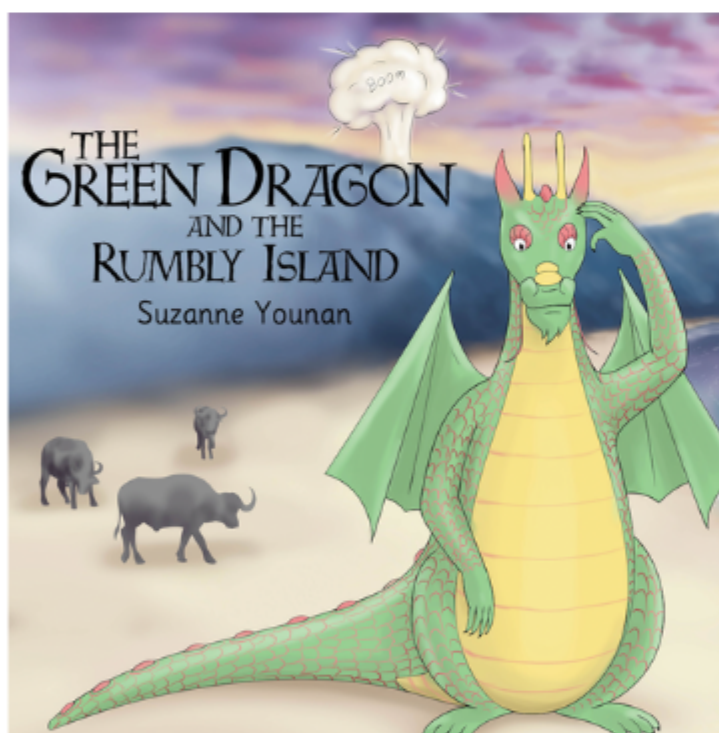
'The Green Dragon' series of environmental stories for children.



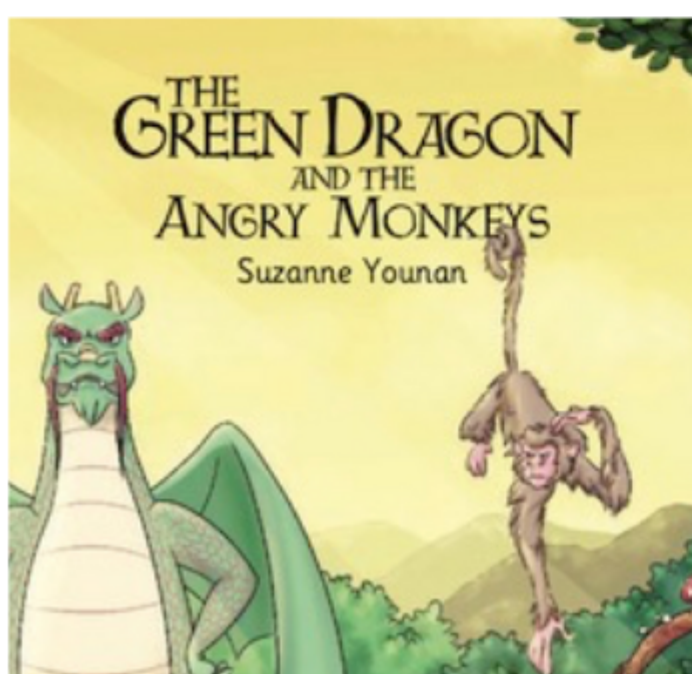

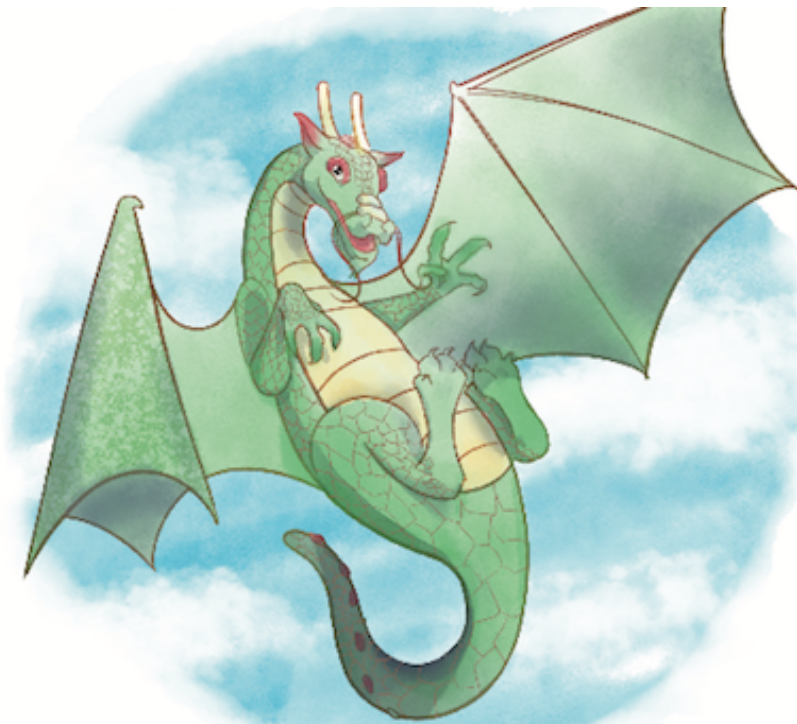
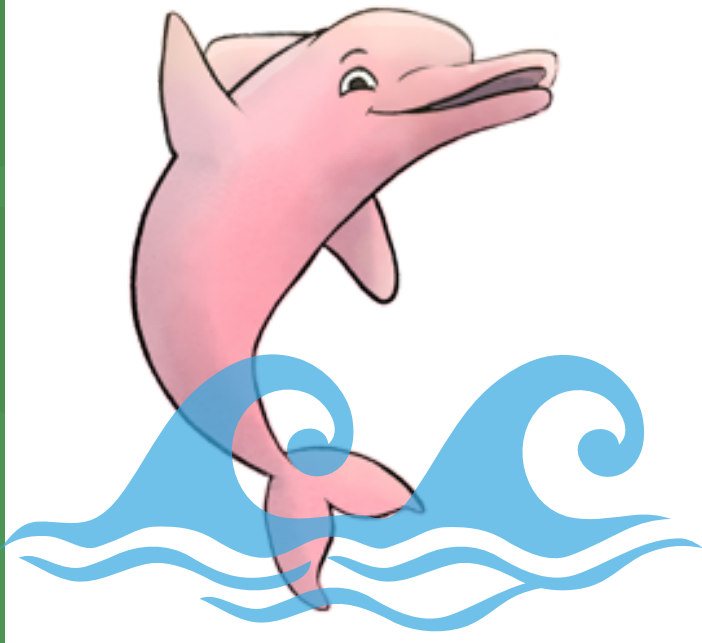

...is a story of modern times, friends and taking action.

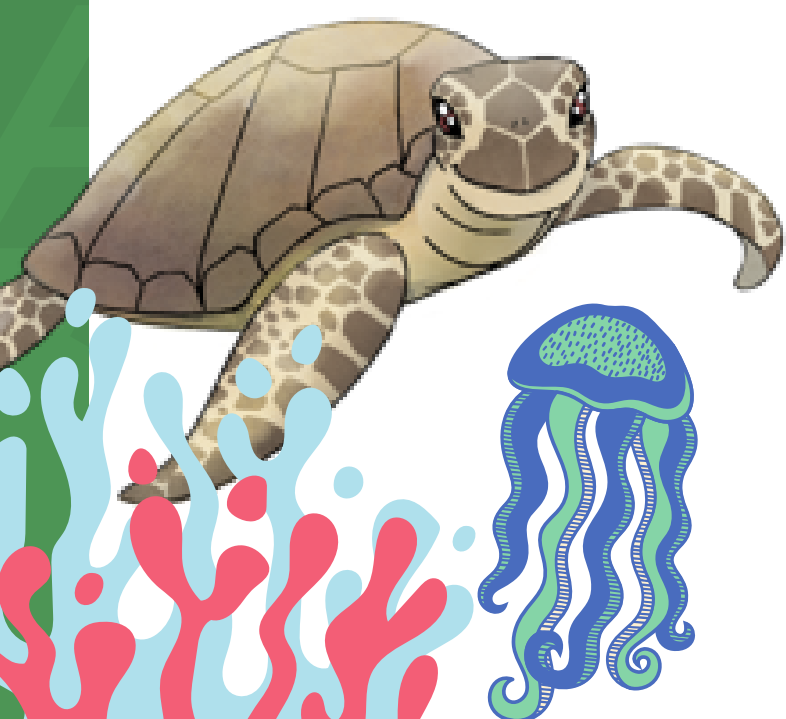
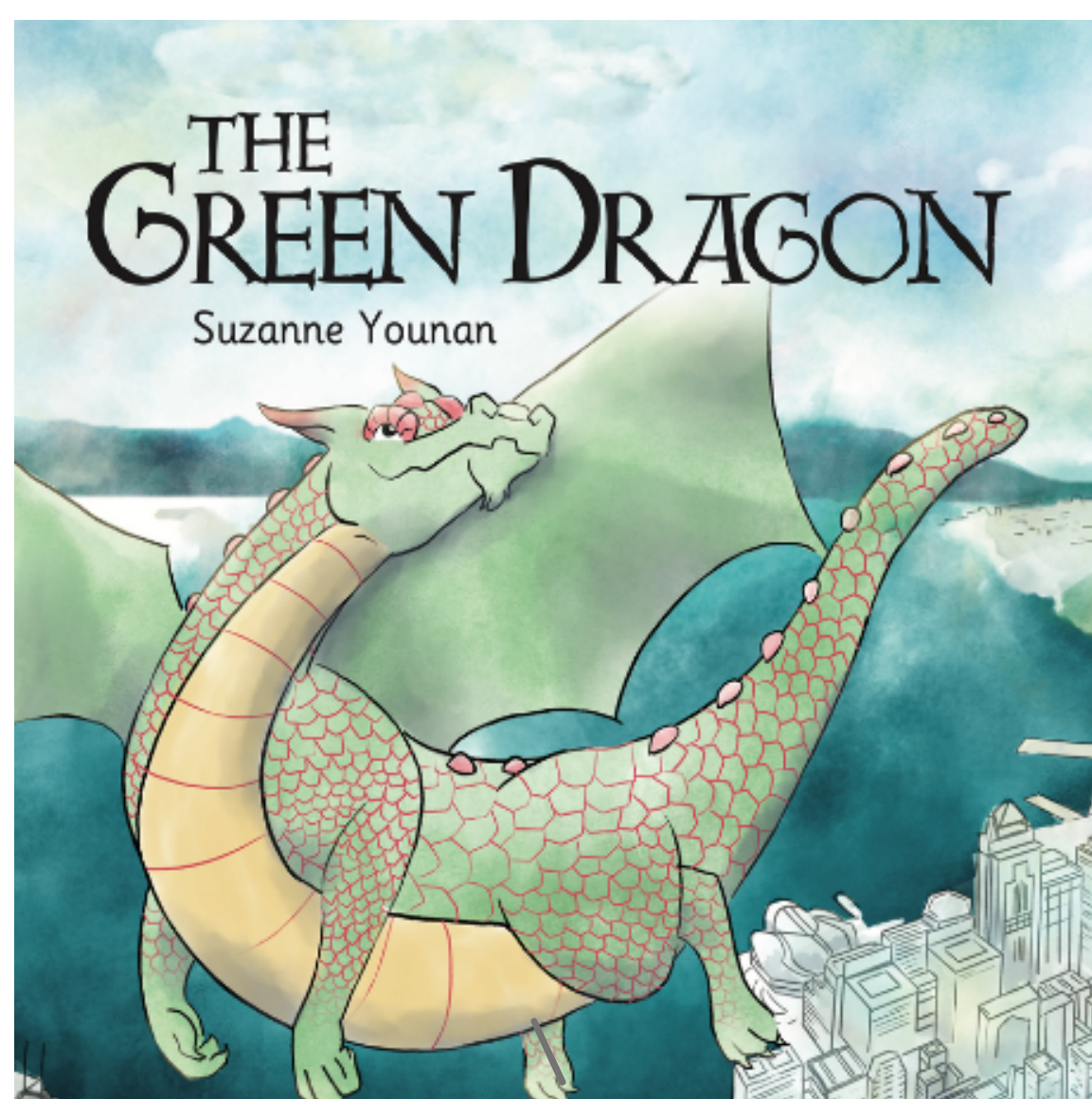
Follow Willy, The Green Dragon as he soars over islands and beaches of Hong Kong.

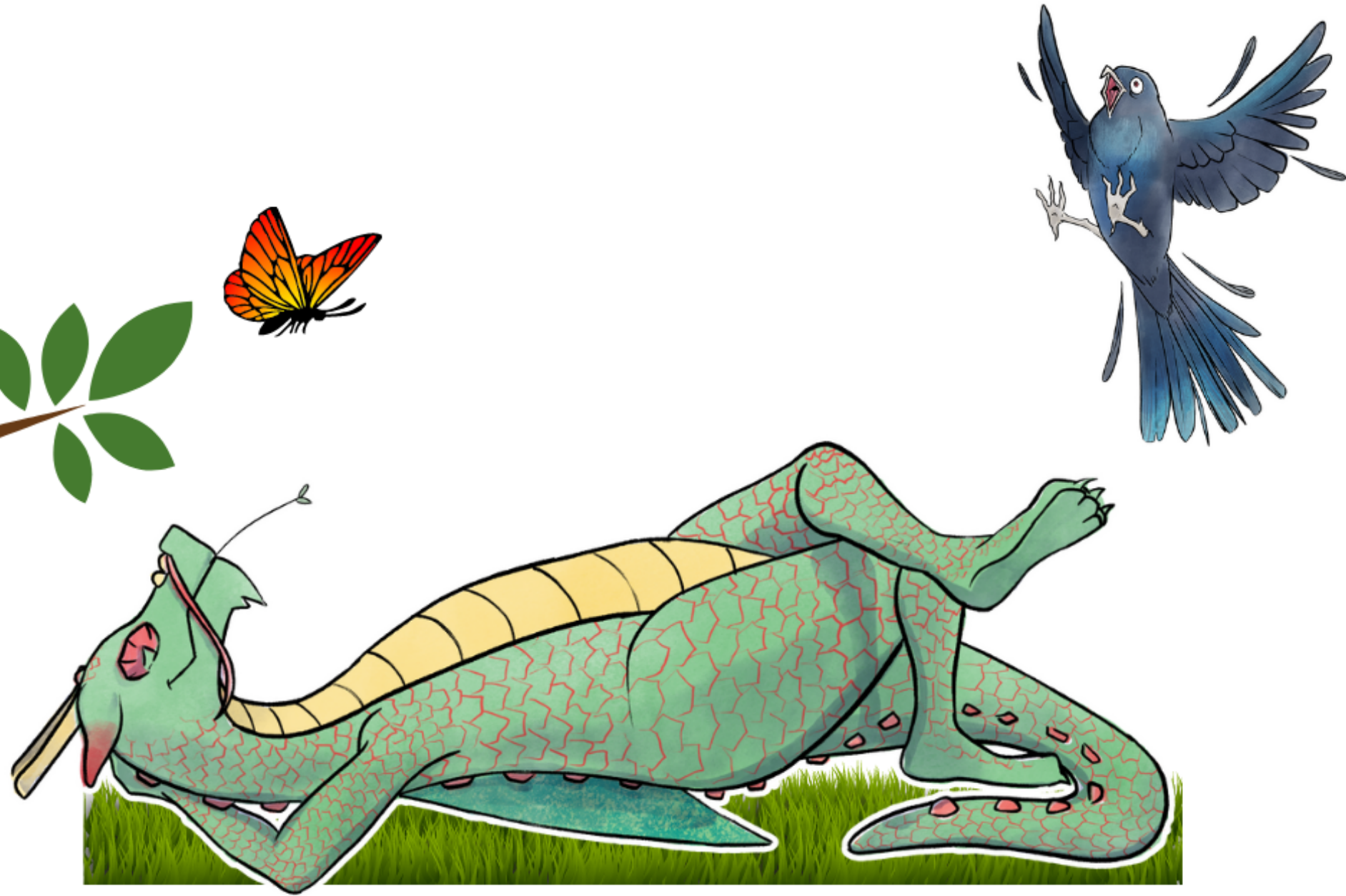

The Green Dragon and the Rumbly Island



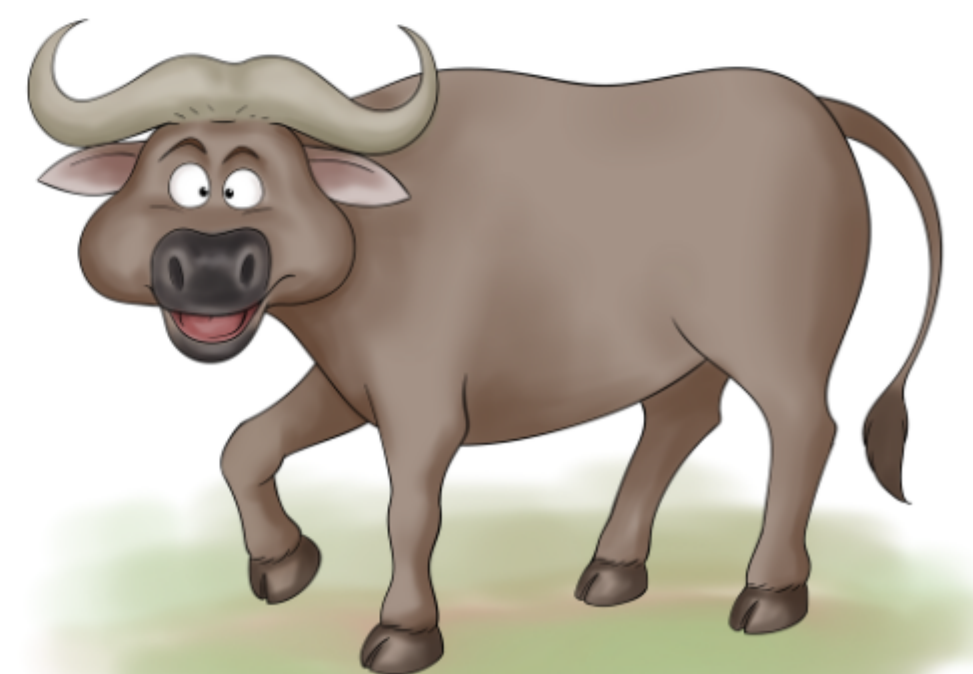
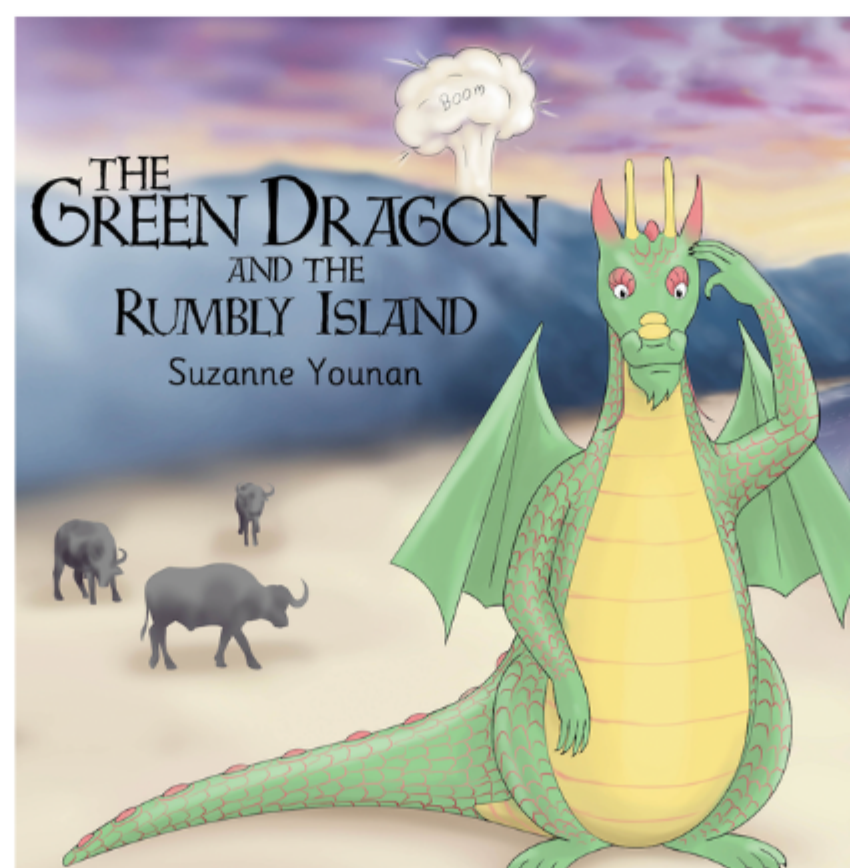
The third book in the Green Dragon series,

The fourth book in the Green Dragon series, released February 2023.

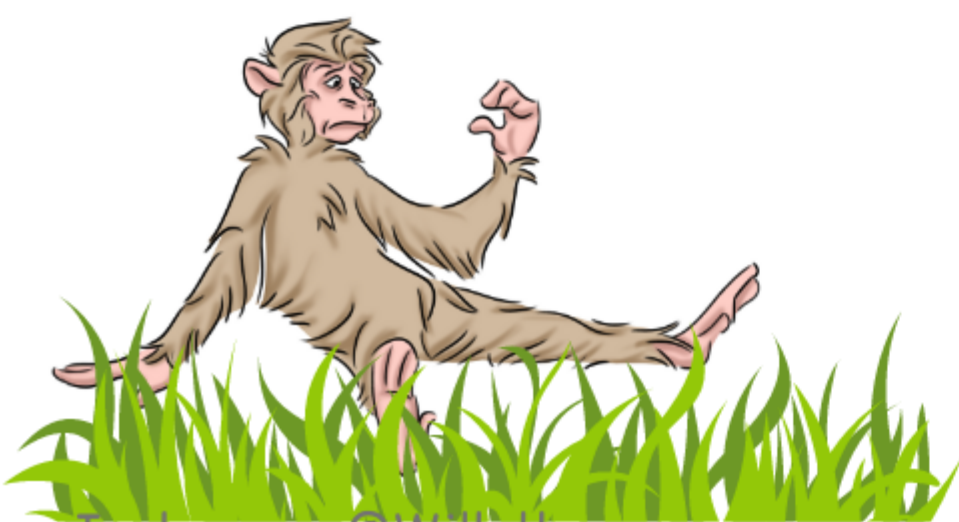
Willy needs some alone time to work out a problem. Something has been bothering him for a long time.

Find out what happens to Willy on his next exciting adventure. Again, based on real events. Another exciting, historical story from Hong Kong's rich past.

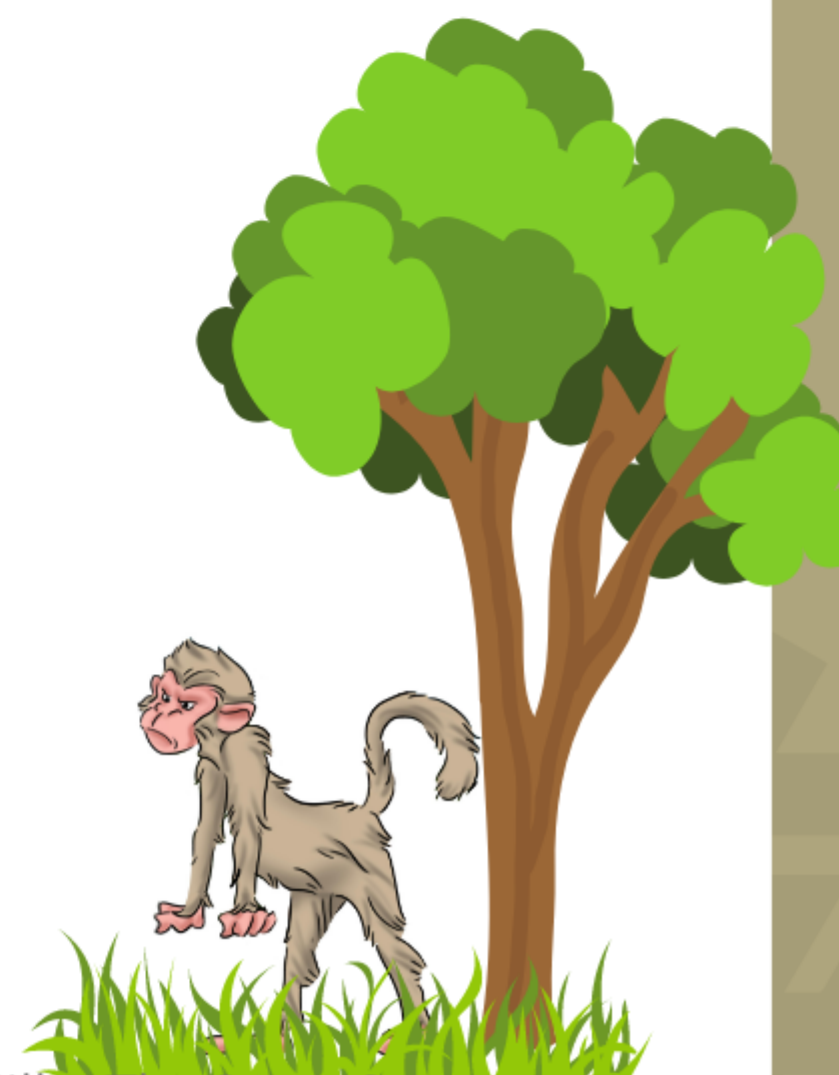

The Green Dragon jigsaw puzzle

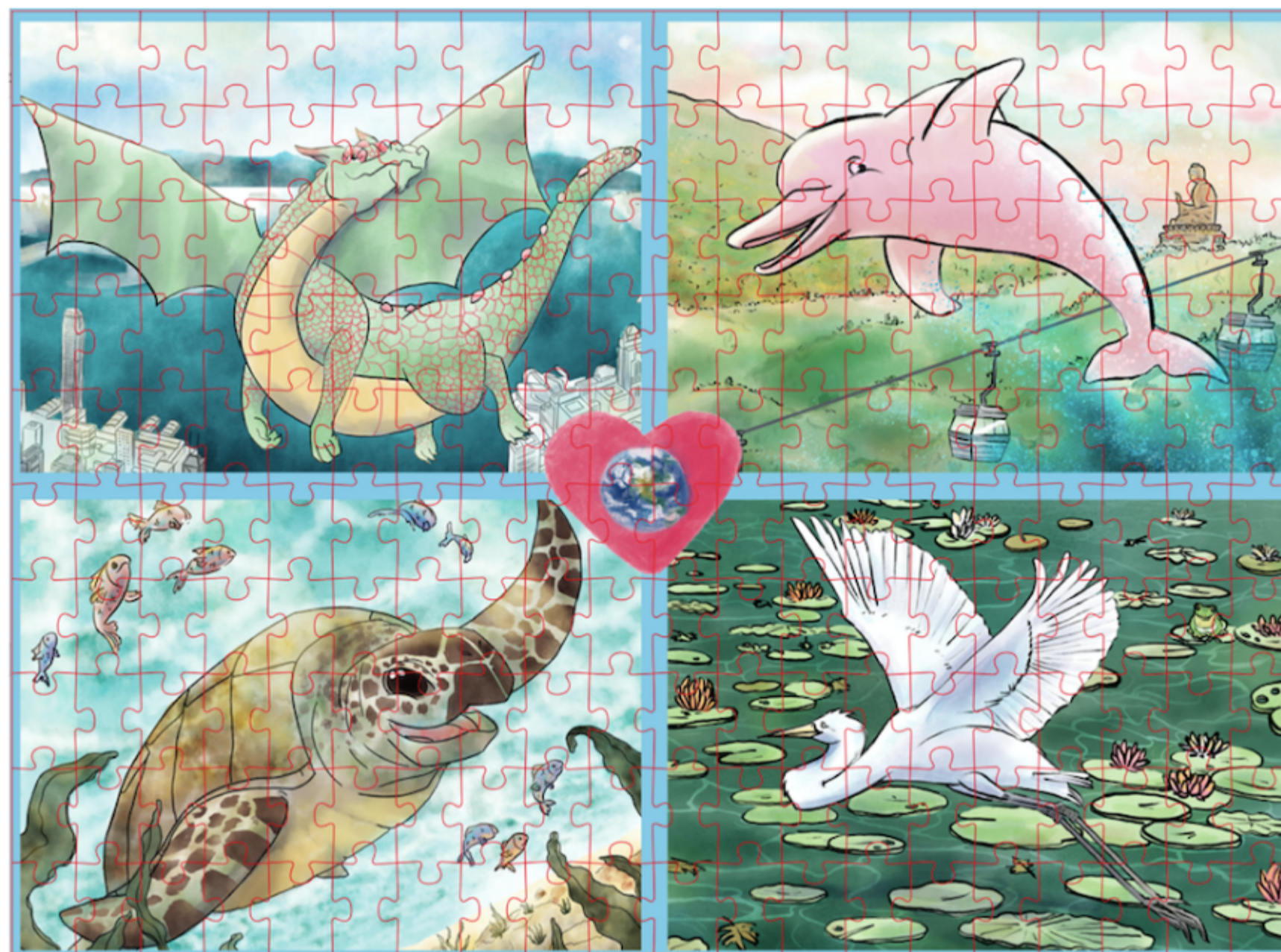
Puzzles are a great way to create a fun learning opportunity for children.

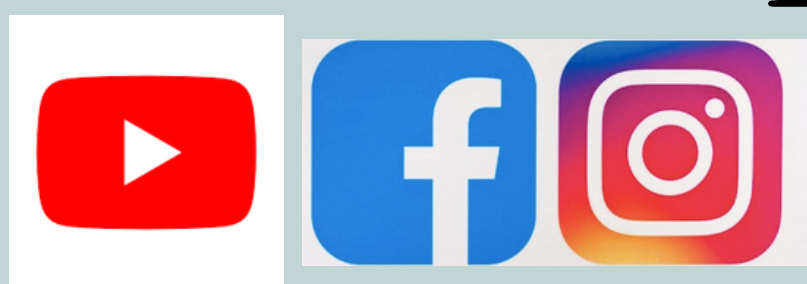
